Bag loads of whole Chinook and Cascade hop flowers as well as some local flowers from Tasmania are thrown at this beer, creating an intense citrus and grapefruit aroma and flavour.				
Austria	2. Eggenberg HopfenKönig	330	5.1	3.00
A lightly golden pils style beer with a mild flavour, fermented and matured for twelve weeks in the historic cellars of Schloss Eggenberg.				
Belgium	3. La Chouffe	330	8.0	3.00
A hazy pale gold beer, spiced with coriander. Excellent blonde ale from a small farmhouse brewery. Strong and fruity.				
	4. Het Anker Maneblusser	330	6.0	3.00
A fresh and fruity blond beer, brewed in accordance with the traditional method of top fermentation with re-fermentation in the bottle.				
	5. Chimay Blue Cap	330	9.0	3.20
A Trappist beer of great tradition. Chimay Blue is a dark, strong ale characterised by its full flavour and port-like aroma.				
	6. Kwak	330	8.4	3.20
A dark, warming beer with liquorice-like flavours and a slightly spicy character. The bitterness always remains in the background but in the end emerges delicately.				
	7. De Troch Chapeau Banana	250	3.0	2.50
Sweet lambic beer flavoured with banana by a small producer from Wambeek near Brussels.				
	8. Dubuisson Bush Ambre	250	12.0	3.20
A distinctive extra-strong brew matured for three months and with a nutty taste and distinct hop flavour.				
	9. Halve Maan Brugse Zot Blond	330	6.0	3.00
A great beer which brings refreshment and cleansing of the palate. A fruity dryness and conservative use of hops result in the lack of an outspoken bitterness.				
	10. Floris Chocolat	330	4.0	2.70
Wheat beer blended with chocolate essence to give a smooth chocolatey taste.				
	11. Floris Honey	330	4.0	2.70
Pale gold wheat beer, sweetened by the addition of Belgian honey.				
	12. Floris Ninkeberry	330	3.0	2.70
Light in colour, slightly sweet with apricot, mango and peach flavours mingling on your palate.				
	13. Lefèbvre Hopus	330	8.5	3.20
Five different hop varieties are inserted, which gives great hoppy flavours and a complex flowery treat. A subtle candy sugar sweetness perfectly balances out the hop bitterness.				
	14. Lefèbvre Newton Apple	330	3.5	2.70
Take a quality Belgian wheat beer and add refreshing apple juice from orchards adjacent to the brewery. Sounds mad, but what a wonderful beer is the result.				
	15. Lefèbvre Saison 1900	330	5.4	2.80
The aroma is full of grassy hops, spices and oranges. It is dry, light bodied and lightly funky with notes of honey and a pleasant bitter finish.

	16. Liefmans Fruit	250	4.2	2.70
	A unique, fresh beer blend which matures for 18 months on cherries in the Liefmans cellars, combining the natural juices of strawberry, raspberry, cherry, blueberry and juniper berry.			
	17. Liefmans Kriek	375	6.0	3.90
	A combination of aged brown beer which is mixed with fresh, whole cherries and, after 12 months, is blended with other beers of different ages. Great complexity and a tart finish.			
	18. De Ranke Guldenberg	330	8.5	3.20
	A tripel-style abbey ale. The bitterness comes from the Hallertau hops added at three stages, giving the ale its unique flavour and aroma and its perfect balance between sweet and bitter.			
	19. De Ranke Noir de Dottignies	330	9.0	3.20
	A very rich taste, coming from six different kinds of malt, which also give a rich, dark, nearly black colour. Large doses of Challenger and Saaz hops balance the beer beautifully.			
	20. Roman Adriaen Brouwer Dark Gold	330	8.5	3.20
	A rich dose of caramel malt, followed by tastes of dark fruits. Other background flavours include chocolate, coffee, and spices. A classic Belgian brown ale.			
	21. De La Senne Stouterik	330	4.5	2.80
	An Irish-style dry stout, brewed in Belgium. That's the sort of crazy idea that might just work! Light and dry, with a faint hop aroma and the dark roast malt flavour of a classic stout.			
	22. De La Senne Zinnebir	330	5.5	2.80
	A bright, light, beer with a yeasty complexity, malt backdrop, and refreshing hop bitterness. Golden blonde with a fresh, fruity aroma.			
	23. Timmermans Pêche Lambic	330	4.0	2.70
	A mature beer with a powerful fruit aroma - sweet and fruity flavour with just a hint of bitterness from the peach kernel and skin.			
	24. Timmermans Fraise Lambic	330	4.0	2.70
	An immense strawberry flavour, agreeably sweet and fruity bouquet - a long lingering taste with a powerful nose.			
Czech Republic	25. Bohemia Regent – Prezident	500	5.0	3.50
	The Regent brewery in Trebon is the oldest in the Czech Republic. Prezident is a hoppy, full-flavoured lager with a well-rounded taste.			
	26. Budvar Dark	500	4.7	3.50
	Characterized by its significant dark colour, dry, fine bitter caramel flavour without dominant sweetness. The flavour is made delicious by the roasted malt.			
Estonia	27. A. Le Coq Premium – Viru	300	5.0	2.80
	A golden lager from Tallinn. Viru Beer is brewed using pure deep well water and specially selected barley from across the Baltic region. A clean, balanced palate of malt and hops.			
France	28. Kasteel Cru	330	5.2	3.00
	Champagne yeast and spring water from Les Voges mountains give a slight sparkling acidity to this refreshing treat.

Germany	29. Erdinger Dunkel	500	5.6	3.60
This dark wheat beer is rich and smooth with a chocolate taste and aroma. It owes its full-bodied flavour to the fine hops and dark malt used in its production.				
	30. Flensburger Gold	330	4.8	3.00
A pale golden beer brewed like a pils with a good head, a full, soft and fresh taste and a pleasantly light yeasty bouquet.				
	31. Früh Kölsch	500	4.8	3.60
A dangerously drinkable beer with an unsurpassed balance of malt and soft delicate hops. Pale gold in colour, the hoppy, dry finish is from using Hallertau and Tettnang hops.				
	32. Schlenkerla Marzen	500	5.1	3.60
'Smoke-beer' from Schlenkerla is a dark, aromatic beer which achieves its smoky flavour by exposing the malt to intense, aromatic smoke from burning beech-wood logs at the maltings.				
	33. Schneider Aventinus	500	8.0	3.80
Very intense with a complex spicy chocolate-like aroma, on the palate you experience a complex soft touch, fresh with a hint of caramel. A rich soft and lightly bitter finish.				
	34. Schneider Eisbock	330	12.0	3.80
Eisbock is actually Aventinus frozen and the water is separated from the alcohol, giving the alcohol content a kick up to 12%. Powerful aromas and an intense flavour.				
Italy	35. Amarcord La Mi Dona	500	6.5	3.70
La Mi Dona is the colour of old gold, with a fine compact head and an intense aroma of malted barley. The flavour is full-bodied and rounded, with a persistent after-taste.				
	36. Amarcord La Volpina	500	6.5	3.70
La Volpina has a splendid colour flushed with ruby red. Rich in spicy aromas, giving a warm sensation that enfolds the palate and conquers it with a rounded and persistent finish.				
Jamaica	37. Dragon Stout	284	7.5	3.40
A great sweet/malty stout full of licorice, coffee and chocolate flavours. Reminiscent of Mackeson's at its best.				
Kenya	38. Tusker	500	4.2	3.50
Dryness and bitterness predominate in this well-hopped African beauty. Good quality lager, with plenty of punchy hop character and a lingering finish.				
Mongolia	39. Baadog	330	4.6	3.00
A Vienna-style lager with an earthy, smoky aroma. The initial flavour is of toasted malt, which is pleasantly balanced by some light hop bitterness.

Slight citrus and toffee aroma leads into a full malty lager, with a decent hoppy finish. Doesn't taste its strength!				
	41. Redds Apple	500	4.5	3.50
A dark golden beer with (surprise!) a refreshing apple flavour – a hint of ginger gives it a pleasant zingy finish.				
	42. Redds Red	500	4.5	3.50
The aroma is of raspberries, but the flavour hints at other red fruits being involved – hence the name!				
Spain	43. Alhambra Reserva	330	6.4	3.00
Crisp, clean and tasty, with plenty of body and some bitterness. The prince of Spanish beers.				
Thailand	44. Singha	330	6.0	2.80
Premium lager with a hint of sweetness. The hop aromas suggest lemon flowers and cinnamon.				
United States	45. Anchor Liberty	355	5.9	3.10
Liberty Ale is brewed with a top-fermenting ale yeast, responsible for many of the subtle flavours and characteristics. Dry-hopping imparts a unique aroma to the ale.				
	46. Brooklyn Black Chocolate Stout	355	10.6	3.40
The brewers use three mashes to brew each batch of this beer, achieving a luscious deep dark chocolate flavour through a blend of specially roasted malts.				
	47. Flying Dog Raging Bitch	355	8.3	3.40
Flying Dog's 20th Anniversary beer, an American IPA augmented with Belgian yeast. Raging Bitch is dangerously drinkable and has a delicate hop bitterness.				
Vietnam	48. Hue Beer	350	5.0	2.80
Lightly malty, slightly sweet palate gives way to a lightly hopped finish.
